**HEARING OF THE PUBLIC:**

He is stating that his neighbor Marty Drennan has dead pine trees that are a fire hazard, 53 box trailer that has been sitting on the property and a water tank that has been sitting on the property and as far as he knows could have hazard materials in it. He came with a copy of the zoning resolution and stated that these are violations of the zoning. He believes that he hs trying to make a barrier with all these things.

Sonata Black was also in attendance and just wanted to speak- that her husband has passed away and she is now there by herself. She is tired of being harassed and accused by the Drennan's family and family members. She stated that she has even been harassed by Sherriff Department family members of the Drennan's.

Adam Mourton tried to speak to this and she did not want to hear what he had to say.

As the Trustees have said in the past they are not getting involved with a neighborly dispute.

**Local Reports:**

A. Fire Department—Duane

- June calls were 4 EMS and 2 wires down.
- There was a training with Wellington Fire Department.
- Chief Meeting – the Avon Fire Chief is retiring and he is going to be working on a program Mental Health to help first responders and this will be also with the NORD Center.
- No news on the skid unit right now.
- 4<sup>th</sup> of July went well.
- Laura had received some paperwork in regards to Emergency Management and paperwork not being filled out – Duane looked into this and the township is all good – this was related to the Village.

B. Zoning – Ben reported

- No permits this month just some phone calls with questions.

C. Roads – Ben reported

- The second week of August the Chip and Seal is planning on being done.
- 100 tons of stone has already been delivered in the yard.
- New blades for the mower have been ordered and have been delivered.
- Stewart Road there is a spot that is pretty wet and that there is standing water, he is going to look into seeing what can be done.
